PURPOSE: This program is designed to enable students who have not met the Pupil Progression Plan requirements to remove the deficiency to be considered for promotion to the next grade. Students will have the opportunity to enroll in **ONE** course. .

REGISTRATION: Monday, June 4, 2018, from 9:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. at the site which student plans to attend, either Clearwood Junior High or Mandeville Middle School. A parent or guardian must accompany each student at registration.

TUITION: The tuition fee is \$210 and must be paid in full at registration. Fees may be paid in cash, check or money order payable to site attending. After 3 days of class, no refunds can be made.

TRANSPORTATION: A parent may transport to the ESS site or centralized pick up transportation will be provided to the site.

CLASS SCHEDULE: Class will meet Monday – Friday from June 7 to June 28 from 8:00 am until 12:00.

COURSES: Courses will be scheduled for grades/subjects in which there is sufficient student enrollment for the class (minimum 12 students). If there is an insufficient number, fees will be refunded. Every effort is made to offer core subjects.

CREDIT: The purpose of summer school is to offer coursework that will enable a student to earn credit for a course he/she failed during the regular school year.

ATTENDANCE: A student must attend a minimum of sixty (60) hours of instruction to receive credit for course work. Any absences should be for emergency only. A student who exceeds twelve (12) hours of absence cannot be awarded credit. There can be no refund of fees.

BEHAVIOR: Students are expected to exhibit proper acceptable behavior at all times. If, in the judgment of the teacher and/or administrator, a student does not exhibit proper behavior as stated in the St. Tammany Parish Public Schools District Handbook for Students and Parents 2017 - 2018, he/she will be removed from Summer School. No refunds can be made.

DRESS CODE: Regulations for dress are the same as for the regular session; however, uniforms are not required.

REPORT CARDS: Final grades will be mailed to parents at the end of the session. The school the student last attended will be notified of credit earned so that retention can be removed and the student promoted to the next grade after meeting Pupil Progression Plan requirements.
