

# Unit 1 Module B Living Together: This is Home Kindergarten / ELA

### **Unit 1 Module B Description:**

Students will answer questions about key details in informational texts. Students will write a sentence that explains information. Learners will identify different environments and their effects on living things.

### **Target Standards:**

#### **Reading Information:**

RI.K.1: With prompting and support, identify the main topic and retell key details of a text.

### Writing:

W.K.2: Use a combination of drawing, dictating, and writing to compose informative/explanatory texts in which they name what they are writing about and supply some information about the topic.
